The Master of Education in Educational Administration degree program at Grand Canyon University prepares principal candidates to pursue a position in school administration. This online Master's in Educational Administration degree is ideal for candidates who are interested in working in PK-12 administration in public, private or charter schools.

This degree, offered by the College of Education, is a regionally accredited program approved by the State of Arizona. *Upon graduation, students will need to apply to Utah State Office of Education for licensure in Utah.*

- Admissions is on-going throughout the calendar year.
- Courses begin and end based on your schedule.
- Online learners benefit from the convenience of studying anytime and anywhere, while still learning from highly qualified leaders in this field.
- All applicants must provide documentation that verifies a minimum of two years of teaching experience.
- Online classes for this program are six weeks in length.
- The degree requires a total of 36 credits for completion.
- This degree includes three internship experiences for a total of 270 internship hours
- Principal candidates must obtain any necessary certifications or licenses as required by the state in which they wish to work.
